This addendum has been issued to address questions submitted during the inquiry period:

- 1) It is our understanding that Blue Ridge Behavioral Health plans to utilize two pharmacy providers within its organization. Would BRBH be open to including the existing location as part of this RFP?**

No. Blue Ridge Behavioral Healthcare (BRBH) will not modify the scope of the current RFP to include additional locations. Bidders must submit proposals based strictly on the specific locations, operational frameworks, and service requirements outlined in the original RFP documentation.

- 2) What was the reasoning behind issuing a separate RFP for this new location? Was the intent to maintain two different pharmacy providers for checks and balances, or are there other operational considerations? Additionally, does your procurement process allow the current pharmacy provider to operate under the same terms and conditions at the new location?**

The decision to issue a separate RFP was made to meet the specific operational, clinical, and administrative requirements of the new location while ensuring a transparent and competitive procurement process. BRBH reserves the right to determine its operational structure and sourcing strategies to best serve its clients.

Additionally, BRBH procurement rules require a competitive solicitation for this new location. Any current vendor wishing to provide services at the new location must submit a formal proposal in response to this RFP and compete on an equal basis with all other bidders. Contracts cannot be extended to new scopes of work or locations outside of this formal competitive process.

3) Does your current pharmacy provider participate in a 340B program? If so, could you identify the covered entity that enables the use of 340B medications?

No. BRBH is not a 340B covered entity, and there is no 340B program associated with this solicitation.

4) Would you be willing to provide a copy of your current pharmacy services agreement or contract with your existing pharmacy provider? / Request for contract with current provider.

BRBH declines to provide the active pharmacy agreement for current services. All relevant operational data and requirements needed for a submission have been provided within the RFP and related addendum.

5) Could you provide an estimate of the anticipated volume at the new location compared to your current location? For example:

- **Average number of prescriptions dispensed**
- **Patient census or visits**
- **Any other volume metrics that would help us understand the expected workload.**

Because this is a new location, precise historical volume data, prescription counts, and specific patient census metrics are not available. BRBH makes no guarantees regarding minimum or maximum workloads, census counts, or prescription volumes under any resulting contract. Bidders must design flexible operational models capable of scaling to meet fluctuating demand based on the general program descriptions provided in the original RFP. Anticipated volume at the Brandon Facility is expected to remain at least consistent with levels included in section 2.2 of the RFP.
